Subject: Grant of Recognition upto Elementary level under Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application, I am directed to convey the grant of provisional recognition under Rule 14 of Delhi Right to Free and Compulsory Education Rules 2011 and amendment Rules 2013 to the **Shokeen International School** Chhawla-Dhool Siras Marg, Dwarka Phase-II, New Delhi-110071 for class I to VIII for a period of one year w.e.f. 01.04.2013 to 31.03.2014 or till the order to the contrary is passed by the appropriate authority, whichever is earlier.

The above provisional recognition is subject to fulfilment of following conditions:

1. The grant of provisional recognition does not in any way imply any obligation for recognition beyond class VIII
2. The School shall abide by the provisions of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Delhi Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
3. The School shall admit in class I (or in entry class, as the case may be), to the extent of 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.
4. For the children referred to in paragraph 3, the School shall be reimbursed in accordance with the provisions of sub-section (2) of section 12 of the Act. To receive such reimbursements school shall maintain a separate bank account.
5. The Society/School shall not collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.
6. The School shall not deny admission to any child for lack of age of proof shall adhere to the provisions of section 15 of the Act. The school shall ensure:
 - I. No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education in a school
 - II. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - III. No child is required to pass any board examination till the completion of elementary education.
